### **Propane Fills**

If purchasing propane, please come to the store to pay for the tank you would like to be filled. You will be given a tag with your name on it to attach to the tank before you leave it at the gate by the shop. We fill tanks 12:30 and fill and deliver tanks at 3:30. The 100 pound tanks are the property of the propane company of the propane company and cannot leave the campground to be filled.

**Mail:** We have a new package policy for both Momot Trailer Sales and Blue Haven Campground. Due to the huge amount of mail and packages that we receive during last winter, we have made these new guidelines. We must have written notification that the package is expected along with the approximate size, weight, and expected delivery date. There will be a \$5 service fee per package if we are notified. There will be a \$20 service fee per package if we are NOT notified. If the package needs special equipment to be unloaded from the truck, even if notified or not, we will charge a \$100 service fee.
